**ABSTRACT**

Sainik School, Madras State - Establishment - Incurring of expenditure on the provision of equipment -sanctioned.

**ORDER:**

- The Government have decided to start a Sainik School in this State with effect from 1962-63. Its permanent location will be in Kodaikkanal. Pending construction of building there, it will be temporarily located in Amaravathi Nagar from July 1962.
2. Under the scheme for the opening of the Sainik School in this State, the Government of India (in the Ministry Of Defence ) will meet the expenditure of the employment of the Principal, Head Master and the Registrar and the expenditure on other items such as land and buildings for the School, Hostel and Quarters for the staff, equipment and furniture and miscellaneous items will be met by the Government of Madras from their own funds. The overall supervision of the School will be with the BOARD OF GOVERNORS headed by the DEFENCE MINISTER constituted by the Government of India.
  3. The Government of India have appointed Major D.N.Sahni as the Principal-Designate of the School and he is making preliminary arrangements for the starting of the School. It has been reported that for meeting the initial expenditure such as purchase of equipment a sum of Rs.2 lakhs will be required for the purchase of equipment and Rs.1 lakh for meeting other items of expenditure.
  4. The Government sanction the payment of a grant of Rs.3 lakhs (Rupees Three Lakhs only) to the Principal-Designate of the School immediately from the State funds (Rupees two lakhs for the purchase of equipment and Rupees One lakh to be utilised as cash imprest for working capital.)
  5. The amount of Rs.3 lakhs sanctioned in this order should be deposited in the State Bank of India and it will be drawn upon by the Principal-Designate as and when necessary. The Principal-Designate is hereby authorised to open a bank account in the State Bank of India immediately.
  6. The expenditure should be debited "28. EDUCATION-GENERAL-S. MISCELLANEOUS G.ESTT.OF A SAINIK SCHOOL." Necessary funds will be provided by re-appropriation or from savings within the grant in due course. The

Accountant- General is requested to disburse the amount immediately to the Principal- Designate.
